

Wildlife Emphasis Requirements

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA (B average) in all science classes.
- Must take Wildlife Biology
- Complete at least 75 hours of community service throughout your 10-12 years of high school. (They cannot be school or court required hours)
- Take 3 science classes from the classes or areas below:
 - Advanced Human Biology
 - Agricultural Biology
 - AP Biology (if Biology taken previously)
 - Biotechnology
 - Surgical Tech
 - Chemistry
 - Nursing
 - Biology(if taken in 10-12 grade)
 - Animal Science 1
 - Animal Science 2
 - Greenhouse Management
 - Medical Anatomy and Physiology
 - Veterinary Sciences
 - Marine Biology and Oceanography
- Complete two of the following:
 - Compete in a CHHS science fair. Student's project must be approved by a science teacher.
 - Participate in 2 Science days or other activities hosted by a local college or university. Student must provide a summary of the activities as well as proof of registration.
 - Participate in the Bear Facts program here at the school during the summer.
 - Join and participate in either the CHHS Science Club, MESA, FFA or HOSA club for 2 years. Student will need a letter from the club advisor stating that the student was a member of the club and had an active role in the club.
 - Must interview and job shadow someone who has a job related to wildlife. You must turn in a typed report about the job and your experiences. It must be a minimum of 3 pages and needs to include pictures. This must be approved by Mrs. Miller, room 2213
